12% Accumulated probability of outcome

* - note that according to the Cabinet Manual, the Prime Minister needs to command a majority in the House. This might be different to whether there is a majority for their Brexit policy. This assumes no Labour or independent MPs cross the floor to sit on the Government benches.

Diagram based on Conservatives + DUP having a majority of 4, and assumes that Charlie Elphicke - having had the whip withdrawn - still votes with the Conservatives.
