

# Brexit - what next?

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Grey line / box - possible but prob not calculated

Black line - thin - low probability

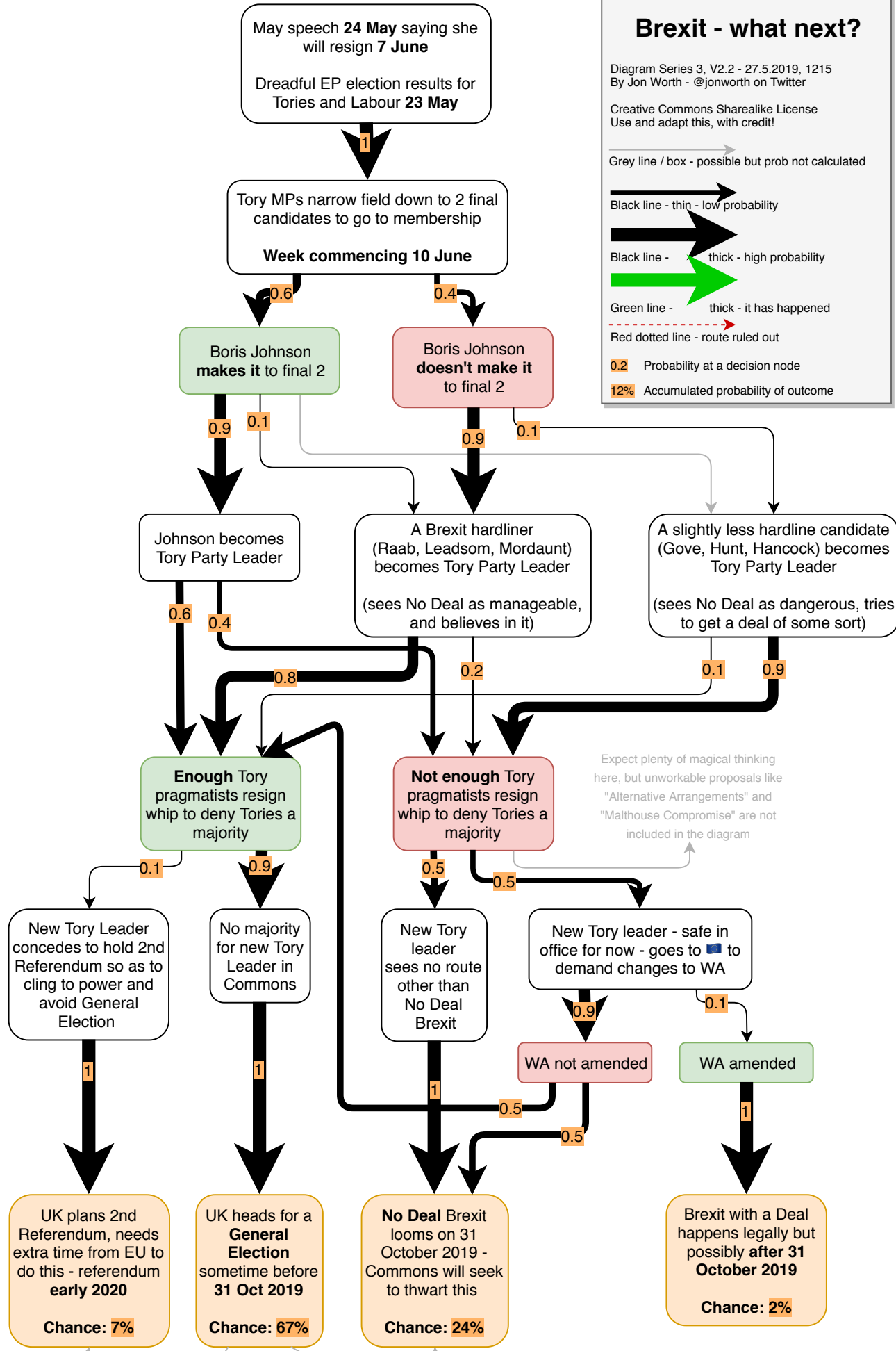
Black line - thick - high probability

Green line - thick - it has happened

Red dotted line - route ruled out

0.2 Probability at a decision node

12% Accumulated probability of outcome



Expect plenty of magical thinking here, but unworkable proposals like "Alternative Arrangements" and "Malthouse Compromise" are not included in the diagram

Signs Labour's position on a 2nd Referendum is starting to move, but this diagram assumes no change yet

A Tory General Election manifesto could demand a No Deal Brexit - and if Remain parties were not to unite this could prevail - too complex to add odds for this currently

Labour could also promise a 2nd Referendum in a General Election manifesto?
