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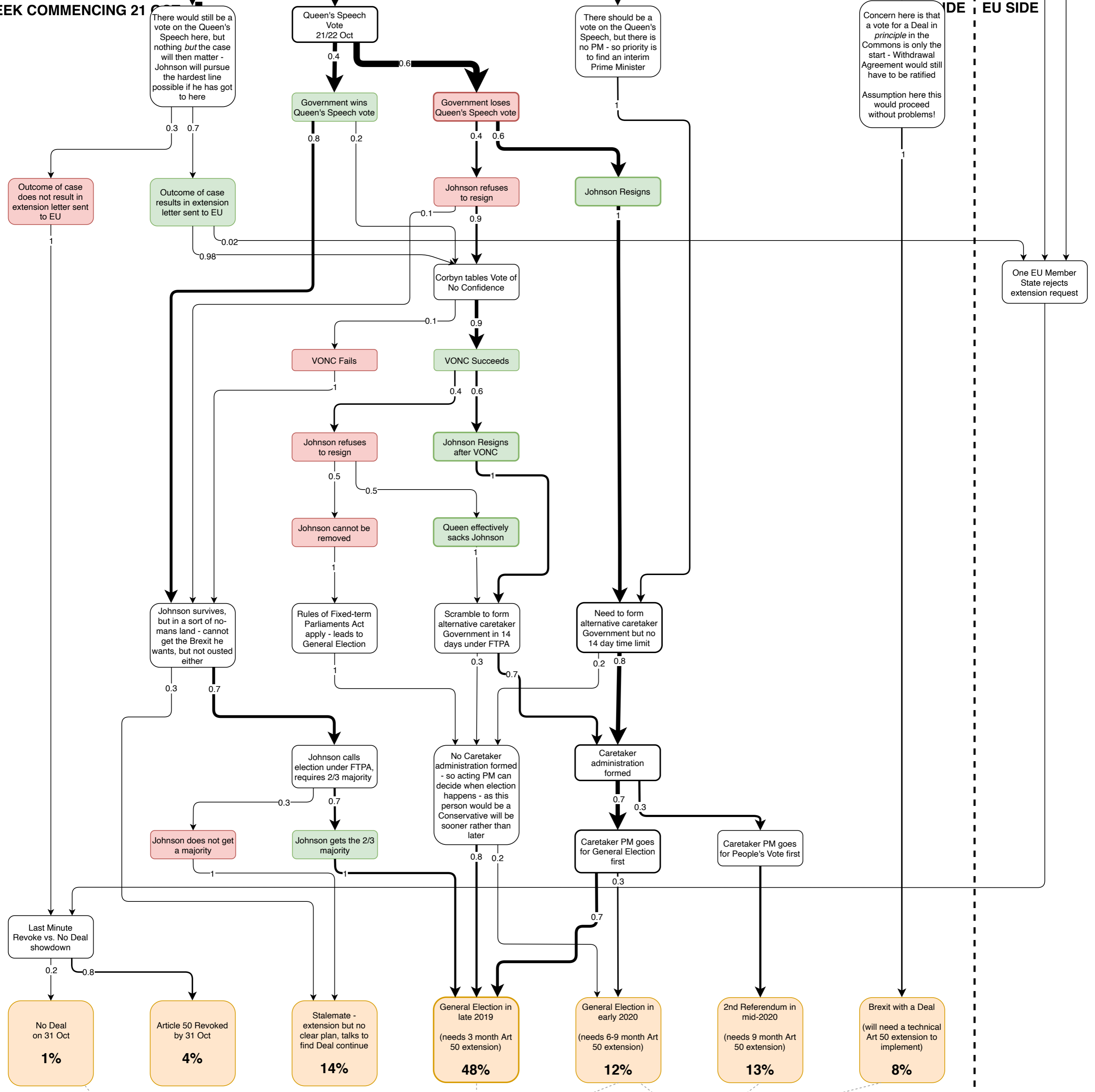
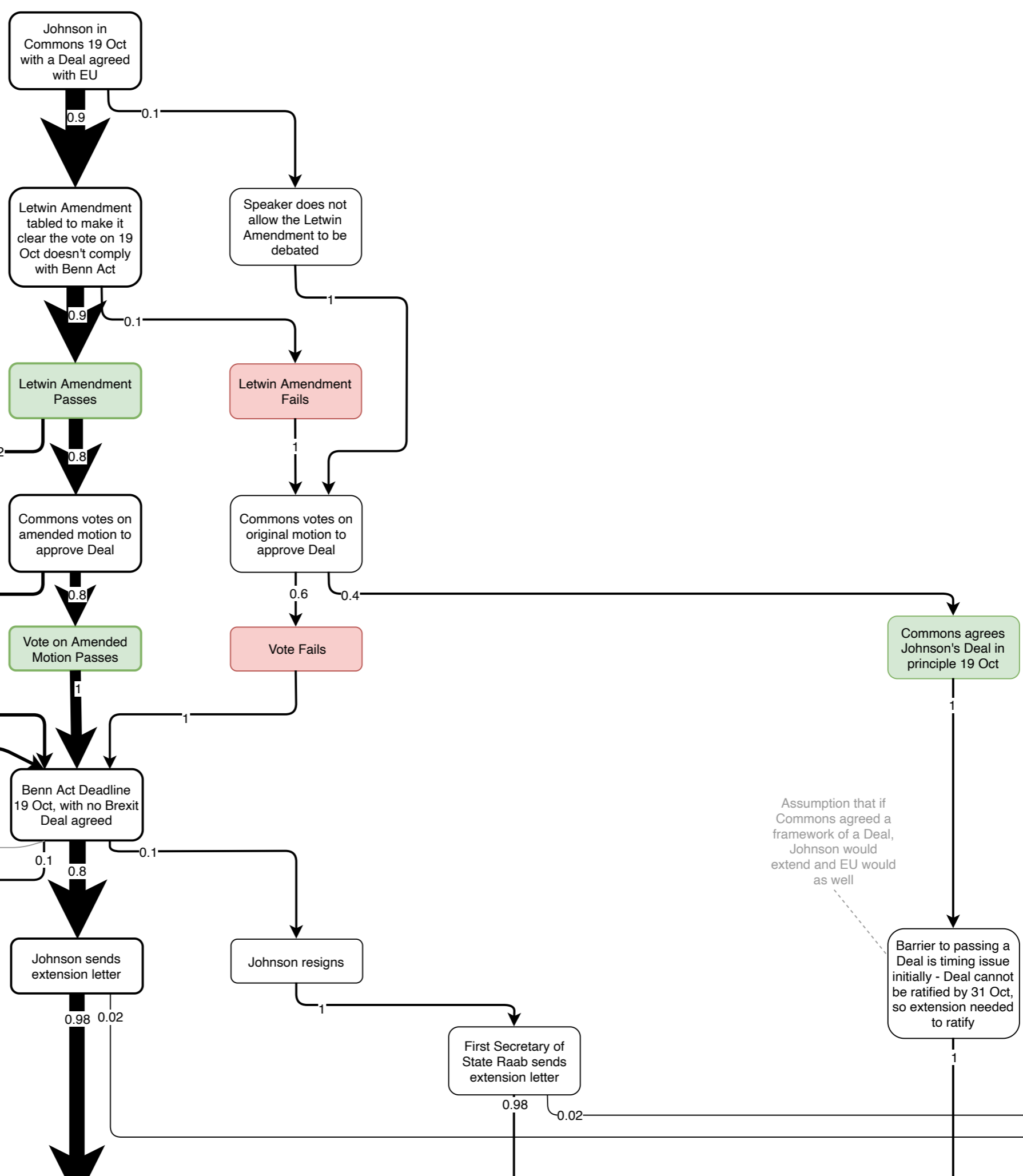

 Diagram is organised chronologically

The thickness of the lines is proportional to  
 the accumulated probability

Probability at each node is indicated with  
 numbers - 0.1 to 1

Grey boxes indicate options which will  
 happen anyway, are for info purposes

Probability of each outcome is indicated as  
 a percentage in the orange boxes at the  
 end



NOTE: this is only the chance of No Deal on 31 October! No Deal after a General Election is still possible but probability not calculable!

Combined chances of GE: 60%  
 And yes, a GE is not an end point - but I cannot predict a GE just now!

Assumption that if Delay is agreed it will be AT LEAST 3 months in length - might need further extension in early 2020 for one of these options

No Deal on 31 Oct  
**1%**

Article 50 Revoked by 31 Oct  
**4%**

Stalemate - extension but no clear plan, talks to find Deal continue  
**14%**

General Election in late 2019 (needs 3 month Art 50 extension)  
**48%**

General Election in early 2020 (needs 6-9 month Art 50 extension)  
**12%**

2nd Referendum in mid-2020 (needs 9 month Art 50 extension)  
**13%**

Brexit with a Deal (will need a technical Art 50 to implement)  
**8%**
