 Diagram is organised chronologically
 The thickness of the lines is proportional to
 the accumulated probability
 Probability at each node is indicated with
 numbers - 0.1 to 1
 Grey boxes indicate options which will
 happen anyway, are for info purposes
 Probability of each outcome is indicated as
 a percentage in the orange boxes at the
 end

WEEK COMMENCING 28 OCT

UK SIDE EU SIDE

NOTE: this box is a bit messy. A >9 month extension might be offered even IF there is no agreement on a 2nd Referendum
 Left arrow goes to left arrow
 2 right arrows go to the 2 right arrows

General Election in late 2019 (needs 3 month Art 50 extension) **64%**

General Election in early 2020 (needs 9 month Art 50 extension) **2%**

2nd Referendum in mid-2020 (needs 9 month Art 50 extension) **2%**

Stalemate - Deal is still possible, but can be agreed only late 2019, and Amendments might derail it still **30%**

Brexit with a Deal (agreed by 31 Oct, might need short Art 50 extension to implement) **0%**

No Deal on 31 Oct **0%**

Article 50 Revoked by 31 Oct **2%**

Combined chances of GE: 67%
 And yes, a GE is not an end point - but I cannot predict a GE just now!

A way out of the stalemate could be a GE or a 2nd Referendum

NOTE: this is only the chance of No Deal on 31 October! No Deal after a General Election is still possible but probability not calculable!
